Notes for APHSA Member Types and Benefits

Five affiliates (*with 2007 Memoranda of Understanding with APHSA*) confer APHSA individual membership with full conference registration, which includes conference and publication discounts as well as bimonthly issues of *Policy & Practice*.

These affiliates are:

2. American Association of SNAP Directors
3. IT Solutions Management for Human Services
4. National Association for Program Information and Performance Measurement

This means that the following affiliates or technical assistance projects (e.g., Center for Workers With Disabilities) do not confer membership nor do they receive *Policy & Practice* unless they subscribe to the publication or join APHSA as individual members.
