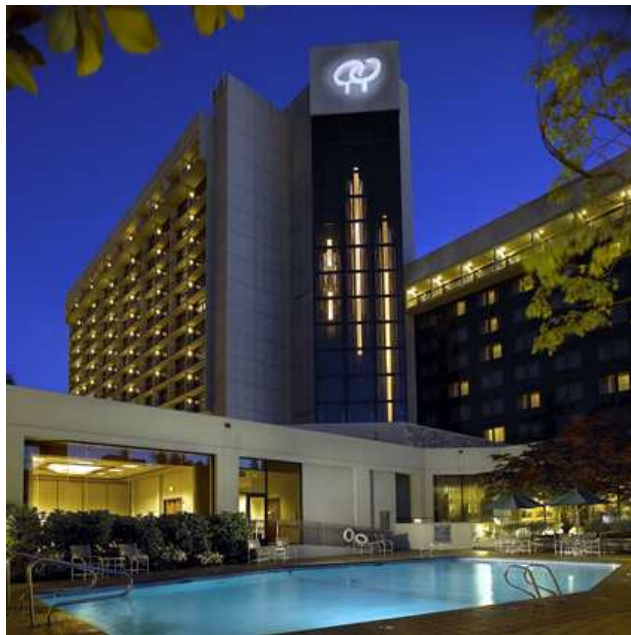

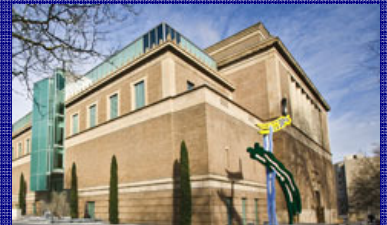
Things to do in Portland
